TREASURER’S REPORT

We are currently staying on budget. We did receive the \$10,000 grant we applied for from the district. We also received a one time \$1200 donation from a couple that likes to support the band.

There are currently 14 bands signed up to compete

There is a huge need for volunteers the day of the event. 100 spots need to be filled. Please be on the look out for a sign up. You can sign up for more than one job. 45 spots are for band students. Marching band students will not be signing up as they are competing
